In January 2022 Commsworld was awarded a £150m contract with North Lanarkshire Council to transform digital connectivity across the region, a key element within this contract was the additional benefits it would bring to the community and its citizens with a focus on supporting young people into a career in STEM.

Introduction

In today's rapidly evolving digital landscape, developing an environment that empowers young minds to explore science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) is crucial. The Vision

Through our ongoing partnership, Commsworld and SmartSTEMs support digital education initiatives with a series of events and interactive workshops for 10-14 year olds featuring passionate and inspiring speakers designed to engage and open minds.

What started out initially as a partnership based on a financial commitment for SmartSTEMs to help them deliver and grow their workshops has evolved into something more meaningful. We are fully aligned with SmartSTEMs and their mission, not just a faceless brand behind the work but fully immersing ourselves in the experience of educating and promoting all that STEM can offer.

Engaging Events

In the first year we delivered 20 individual school workshops reaching 1,450 young people in North Lanarkshire along with 2 hub events, one for primary and one for secondary pupils. Across the two days we had 400 pupils from 11 secondary and 12 primary schools.

SmartSTEMs develop and create events designed to capture the imagination of young minds. Through hands-on workshops, interactive demonstrations and presentations from STEM businesses

pupils are invited to explore a wide range STEM disciplines they may otherwise not have had access to. Not only do these events provide an insight into future possibilities but they provide invaluable networking opportunities, connecting students with industry professionals who share their knowledge, expertise and guidance.

These events also strengthen connections between industry and education, promoting equal access to the ladder of opportunity for everyone and focus on the skills required for the world of work such as problem solving, teamwork and communication, whilst highlighting the many pathways into careers.

Awareness of digital career and pathways

Commsworld employees from varied departments throughout the business joined a campaign launched by SmartSTEMs titled #MyJob#MyJourney to share an insight into what their job entails and the pathway that got them there. Whether that was further education, apprenticeships or another means along with

sharing their hobbies / interests and who or what inspired them and to also show that within STEM industries there are many different types of job roles available.

These videos are used to raise awareness of the opportunities available and feature in the individual school visits as well online.

At our May Hub event North Lanarkshire Council cited that one of the highlights of the event was the Commsworld workshop, which provided an immersive and hands-on experience for young participants. Pupils were given a map of their school and its surrounding area, assuming the responsibility of planning the fibre roll-out.
